HiMama App/Program Plan



We will post all of the program plans, with daily, planned activities and send you pictures through this app. We have been planning a wide variety of activities and we encourage all our children to participate. We have many activities that are sensory based to help encourage their curiosity and inquisition. We also have creative activities to help fuel their imagination. We have

open based activities that encourage students to share what they would like to do, we find that this helps with building social and teambuilding skills as they all agree on an activity they would like to do together. In addition, this app also can be a platform to communicate with us; you can send your questions or concerns in a message and we will reply as soon as we can.

Things to bring seasonally:

Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for all weather. We spend a good portion of our program outside everyday and we would like to ensure the comfort and safety of our students. Please provide a change of clothing and extra gloves, mitts, socks etc. Just in case of an accident, visible soiling or to change into dry clothing articles.

7:00-7:30	Clean and disinfect, set up activities
7:30-8:20	Snack is served/free play/planned activities
8:20-8:30	Children begin tidying, washroom routine, get ready for outside, staff clean and disinfect the classroom
8:30-8:45	Outdoor play (weather permitting)
8:45-8:55	Children line up at the door
8:55	School begins

After School Program

2:45-3:10	Clean and disinfect the classroom, set up activities and snacks
3:10-3:25	Washroom routine and wash hand
3:25-45	Circle time: read a book, sing a song, or have a discussion
3:45-4:05	Snack time
4:05-4:40	Free play (include planning activities)
4:40-4:55	Washroom routine/sunscreen cream/clean up/get ready for outside.
4:55-5:30	Outdoor free play (weather permit)
5:30-6:00	Clean and disinfect classroom, and make a program planning

NON-INSTRUCTIONAL DAY- SCHEDULE

7:00-7:30	Clean and disinfect the classroom, set up activities
7:30-8:30	Snack is served/free play/planned activities
8:30-8:45	Tidy up and washroom routine
8:45-9:00	Circle time: read a book, sing a song, or have a discussion
9:00-9:10	Get ready for outdoor play
9:10-10:00	Outdoor play (weather permitting)
10:00-11:00	Indoor play:free play/emergent/planned activities
11:00-11:15	Begin tidying up activities, wash hands, and have a story read at carpet while lunch is set up
11:15-12:00	Lunch time
12:00-1:00	Quiet time:quite activities (whiteboards, puzzles,and art etc)
1:00-2:15	Indoor play:free play/emergent/planned activities
2:15-2:30	Tidy up and washroom routine
2:30-2:45	Get ready for outdoor play
2:45-3:45	Outdoor play (weather permitting)
3:45-4:15	Wash hand and snack time
4:15-4:30	Circle time: read a book, sing a song, or have a discussion
4:30-5:20	Indoor play:free play/emergent/planned activities
5:20-5:30	Children clean up, pack up, and home time!
